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

Happy Valentines Day!



the phone, computer, TV, radio, files, everything! I have pencils and ruler stuck in it to hold up the heavy branches....just hilarious.


I am sorry - but this picture just makes me laugh out loud! I'm tellin ya - I work (and have worked) with some of the greatest people! They make everyday so much fun!
