If all goes as planned - I should close on it in a month and be in it by September 1. Whew! Keep your fingers crossed.


These pictures are not the best because the people were in the middle of moving out when I took



them. None of the "stuff" is mine - including the dog. But I think you can see from the high ceilings and sunlight, that it is going to be a great house.
